

IEP AMENDMENT BETWEEN ANNUAL IEP MEETINGS

We understand that this student's IEP must be reviewed at least annually at an IEP meeting. However, after the annual IEP meeting for a school year, the law permits a student's IEP to be amended without an IEP meeting if the school representative and the parent or educational decision maker for the student agree that a meeting is not needed.

Description of proposed IEP Change(s) and effective date(s):

Johnny will be provided 60 minutes of pull out services for Reading and 30 minutes of inclusion services daily instead of 90 minutes of pullout daily. This will allow him to participate in classroom activities during this time. The team feels that 60 minutes of pullout time is adequate to address his needs in the area of reading. During the inclusion time (30 minutes) special education staff members will be available to assist Johnny should the need arise. (Changes in services must specify the frequency, location and duration of the change of services.)
