

Re: Students exiting from Part C (Infant-Toddler Services) and Part B (Early Childhood) programs

Beginning on February 7, 2007, children's exit data for 3 and 6 year olds can be entered into the On-line Webb System (OWS) using the following timelines:

A child exiting a Part C program at 3 years of age needs a Child Outcomes Summary Form (COSF) completed within 30 days of the last day of services in Part C and entered into the OWS application no later than 90 days after the child's third birthday.

Permanent exit at age 3 is defined as the following: Leaving Part C and transitioning to Part B (with or without parental permission for release of records to Part B).

Leaving Part C at age 3 and not transitioning to Part B: a child exiting a Part B preschool program at 6 years of age needs a COSF completed within 30 days of the child's last date of service in Part B before the child's sixth birthday and entered into the OWS application no later than 90 days after the child's sixth birthday.

Permanent exit at age 6 is defined as the following: a child is in a Part B preschool program and turns 6 (the child is not in Kindergarten).
