Upon submission of the online application, copies of the students' applications will automatically be e-mailed to both you and me as well as to the student (so they have verification of what they submitted). If you would like anyone else at the high school or the high school scholarship committee to also be included as a recipient, please let me know and I will include them.

The Wamego Community Foundation has established a **firm deadline of Friday, April 16th** for each high school to let us know who the recipients of each scholarship will be. **If we do not hear from you by Friday, April 16th, we will assume there are no scholarship recipients and the funds might not be awarded.**
